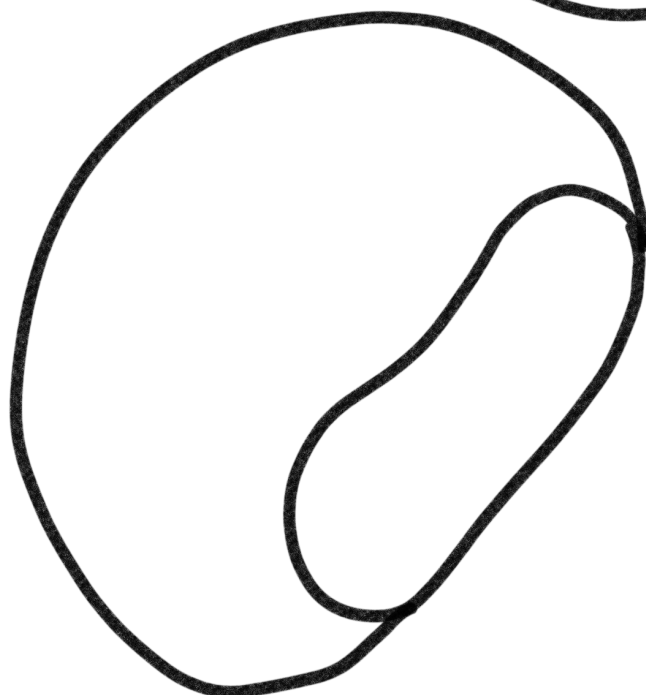
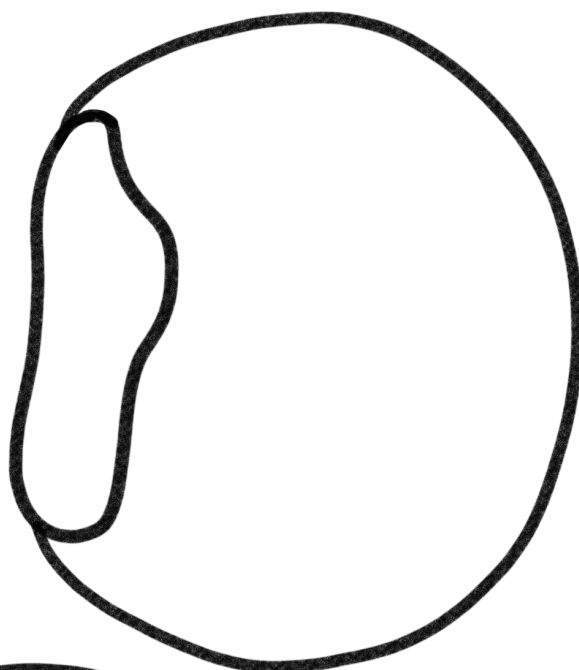


QUICK, TAKE A PHOTO.

WHEN AN ACORN FELL ON HIS HEAD.

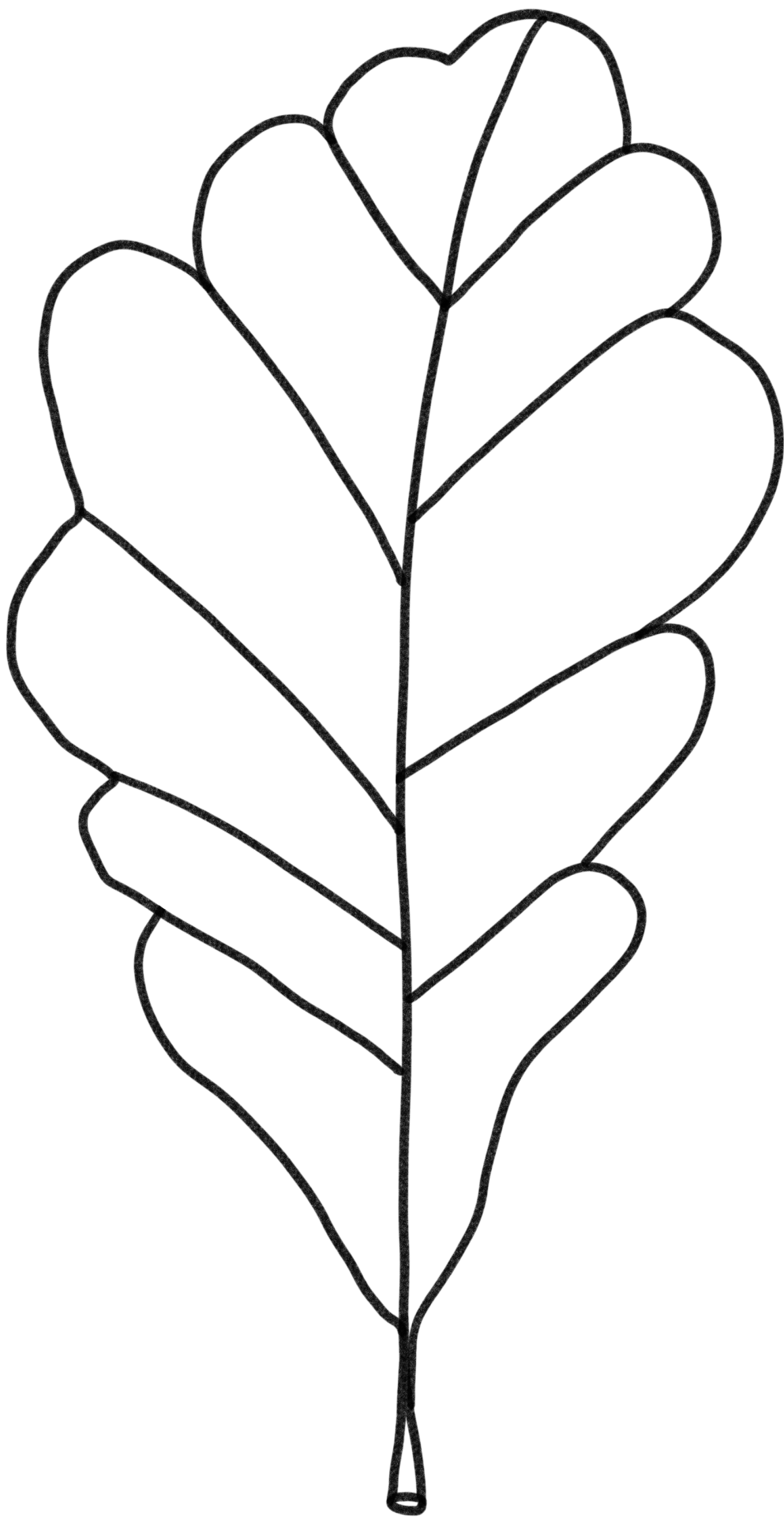


WE ARE COLLECTING CHESTNUTS TODAY.

SEPTEMBER. IT'S MY FAVOURITE FAMILY TRADITION.

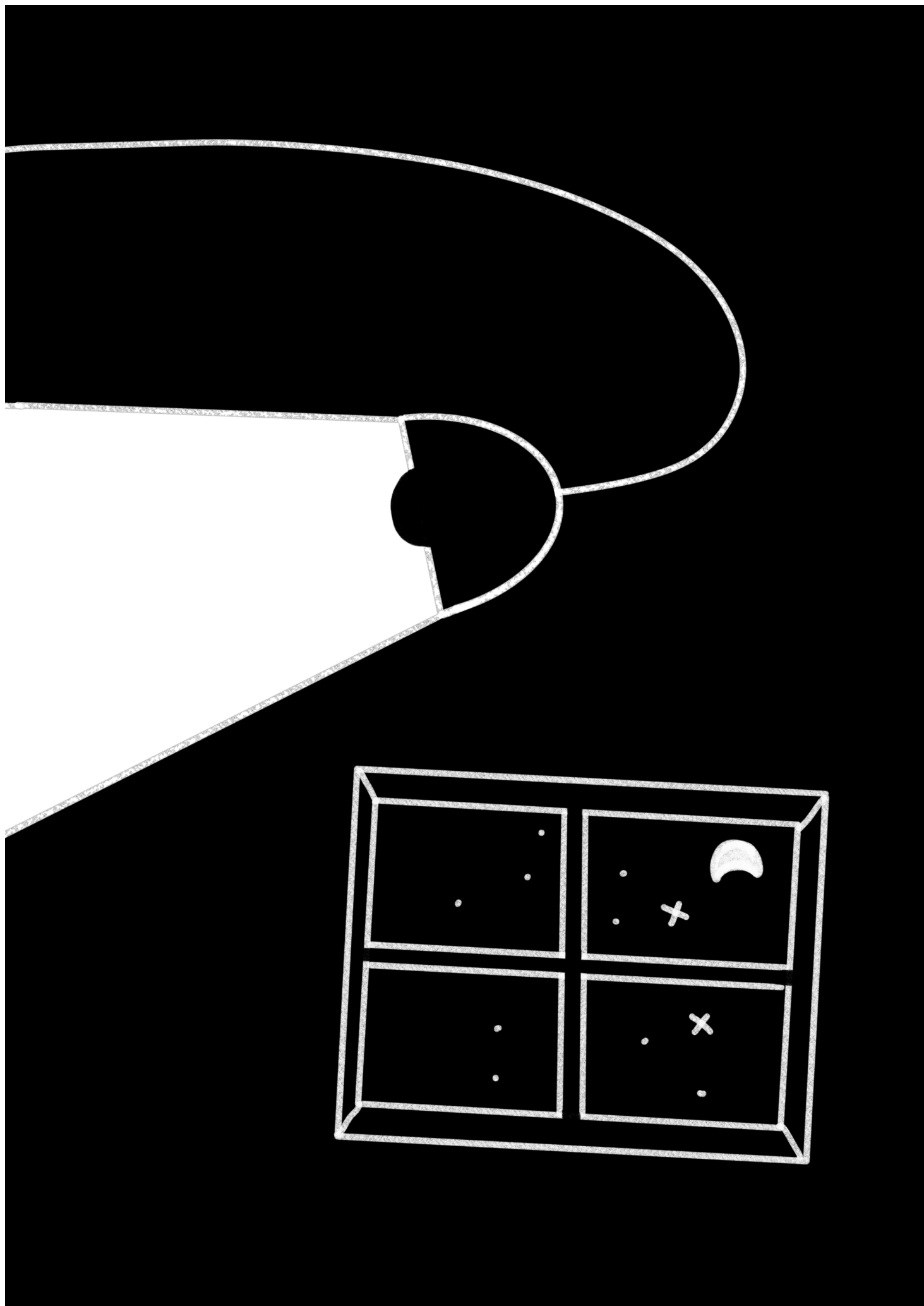

IT BLEW MY UMBRELLA INSIDE OUT.

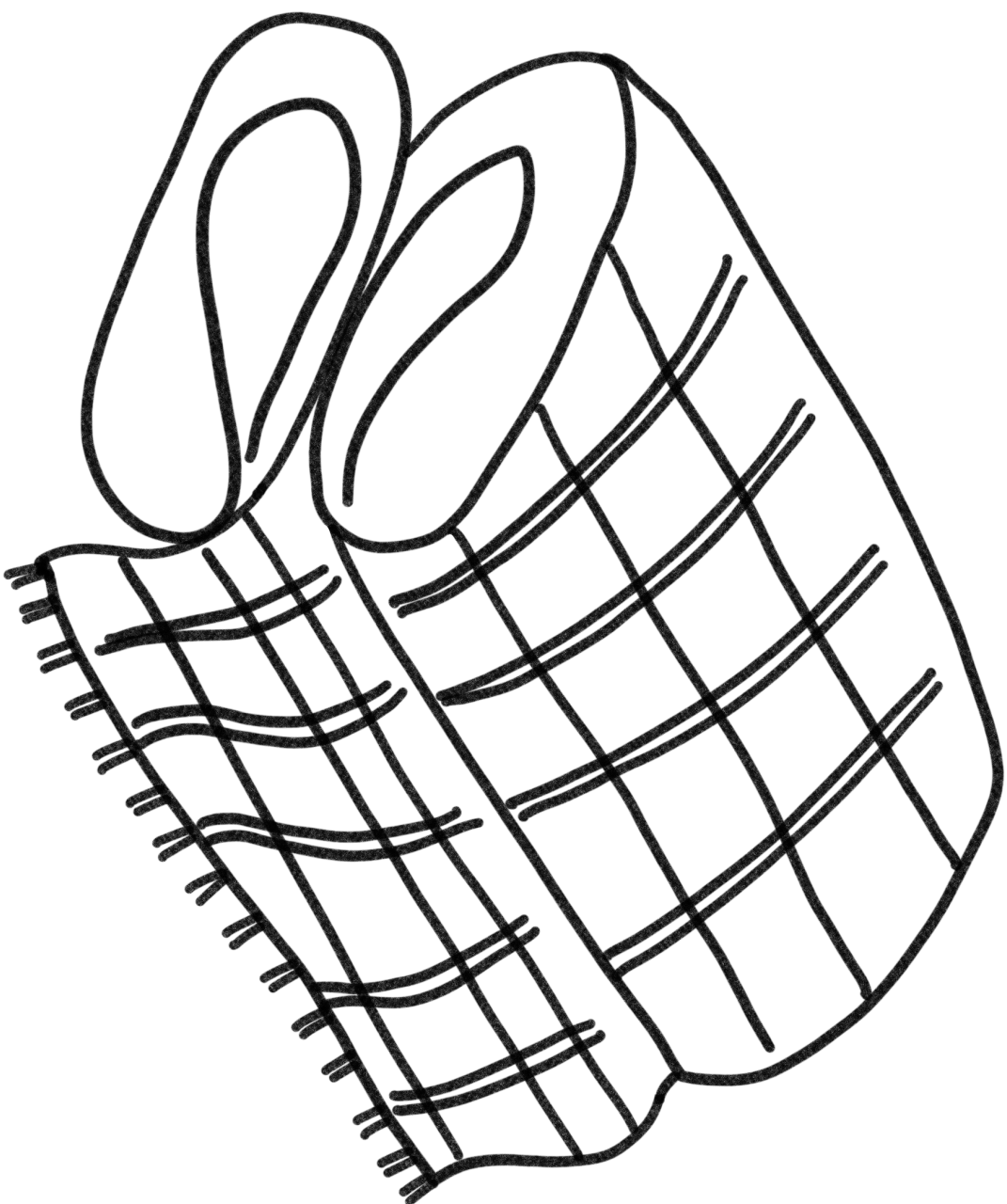

WHEN WE SAW A FOX BEHIND A TREE.

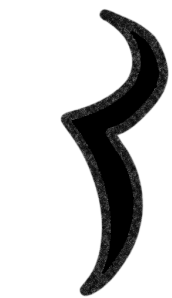


LOOK, THEY'RE SPREADING BLANKETS ON THE GRASS.

UNDER THE BLANKET AND READ A BOOK.

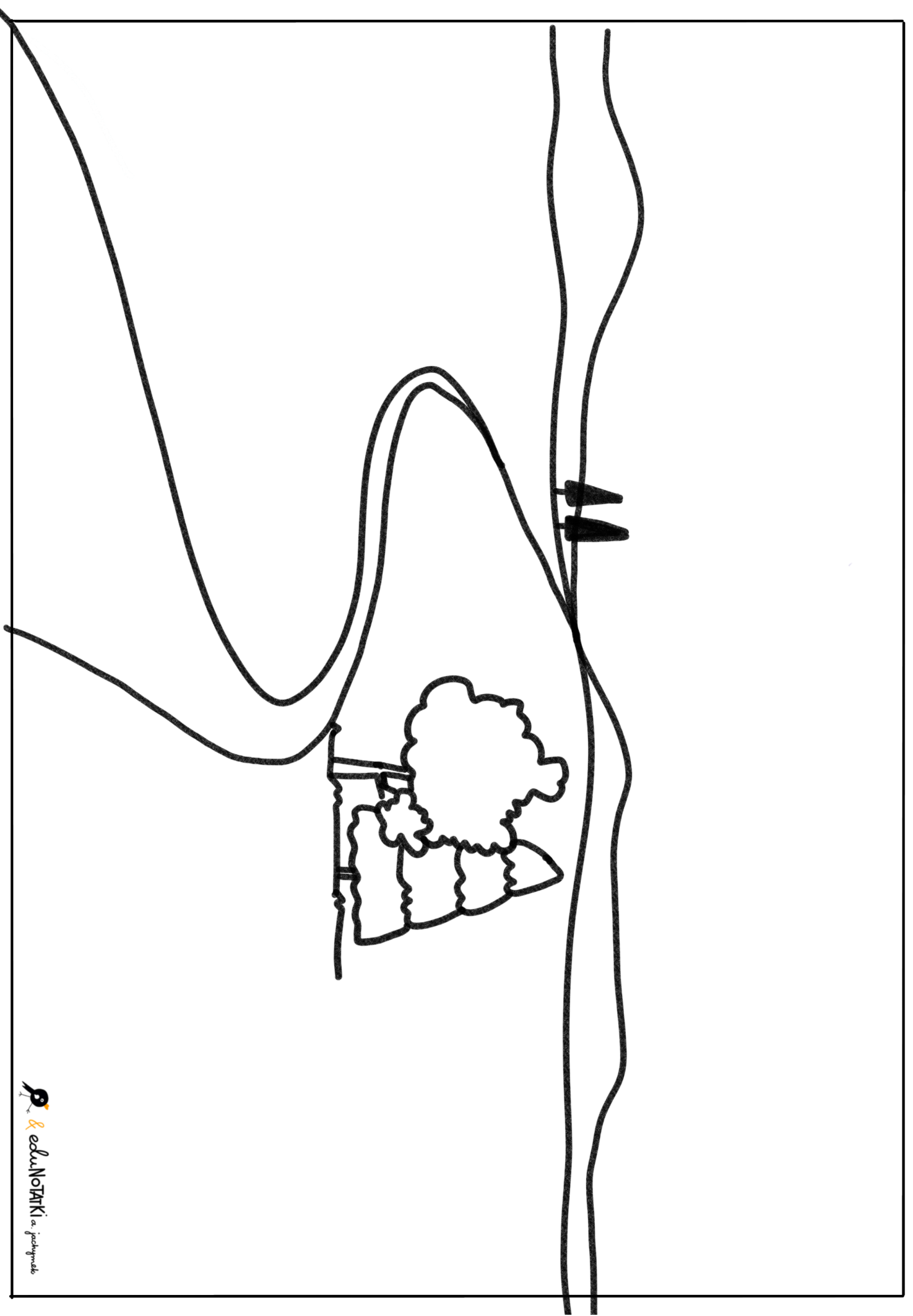
I WRAPPED MYSELF IN A COSY BLANKET

OF A BIRD BUILDING A NEST.

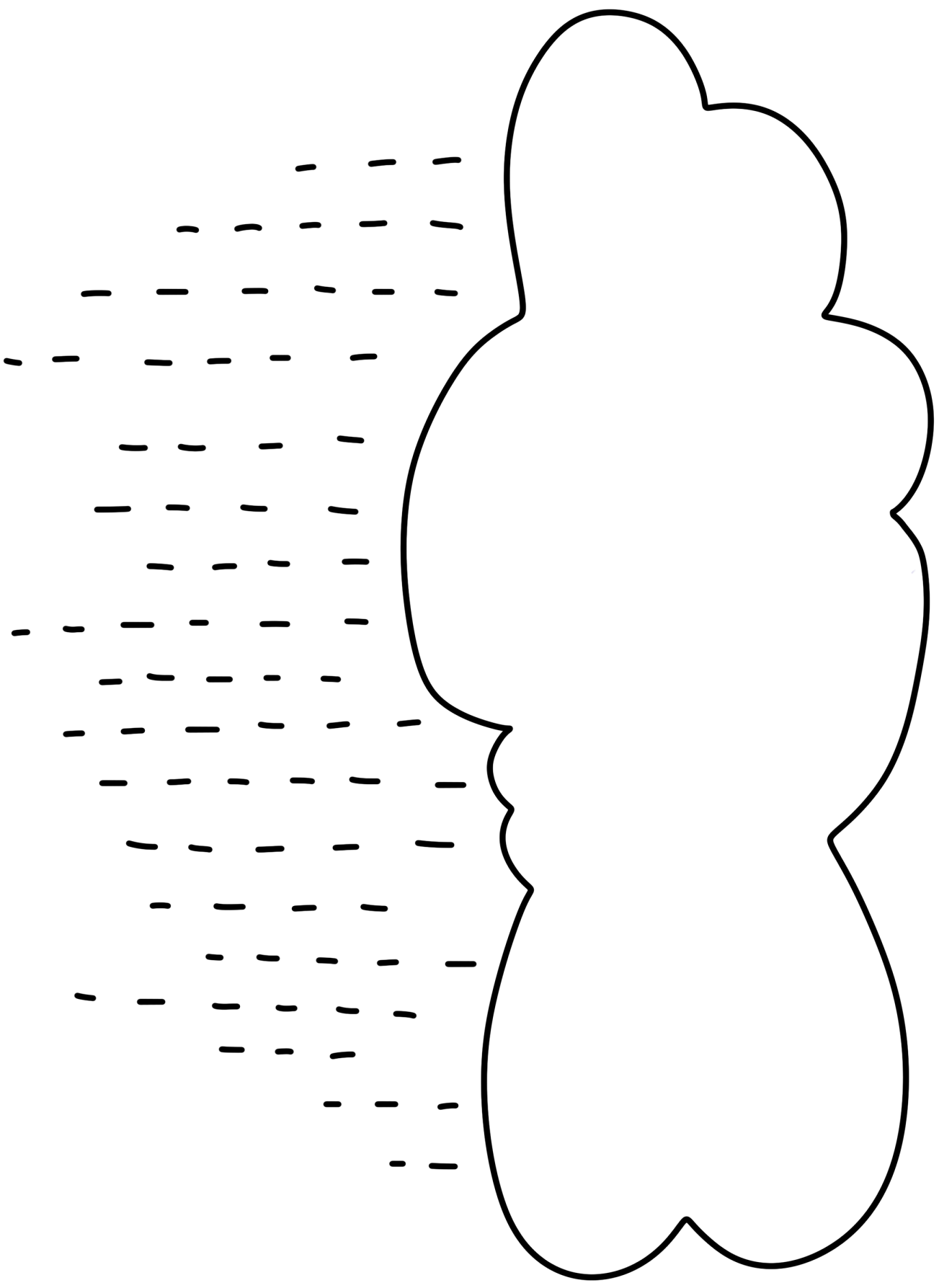
MY GRANDPA WILL BUILD A BIRDHOUSE
